

## KILLDEER COWBOY ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

\*\*\*Scholarships are available for any field of post-secondary study that awards a certificate and/or diploma upon completion\*\*\*\*

### Criteria for all applicants:

- Only complete applications will be given consideration for selection.
- Please **print** all information
- Applications must be in a sealed envelope labeled "Booster Club Scholarship Committee" in the school office no later than April 30th to be considered for selection.
- Scholarship money will only be paid to the successful applicant that pursues post-secondary study and meets other criteria stated herein.
- This scholarship may only be awarded to athletes of Killdeer Public School.
- Applicant information will be verified by using provided application information.

### General Information:

- The Killdeer Cowboy Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Committee will issue four (4) scholarships of \$500 each to two (2) male athletes and two (2) female athletes (as determined by the Killdeer Cowboy Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee).
- The recipients of the scholarships will work with and comply with the Dollars for Scholars rules and regulations. Any unclaimed scholarships may be reassigned by the Killdeer Cowboy Athletic Booster Club.
- The Killdeer Cowboy Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee will decide on the recipients at a special committee meeting. The scholarship will be presented to the selected applicants at graduation.
- Please return your completed application to the Killdeer Public School office. Place your application in a sealed envelope labeled "Booster Club Scholarship Committee"

## **KILLDEER COWBOY ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE:**

- All applicants will turn their applications in to the Killdeer Public School office.
- Person in charge of getting the applications will:
  - Put up a sign at the school to notify students that this scholarship is available by March 31st
  - Have applications & criteria at the front office for students by March 31st
  - Make copies of all the applications
- Use a point system to determine the winners of the scholarships:
  - 5 points for neatness
  - 1 point for early submission (by April 15th)
  - 1 point for attaching proof of GPA – must be 3.0 or higher
  - 1 point for attaching proof of ACT
  - 5 points for each sport participation during high school. (max 30 points)
  - 1 point for each academic honors, awards, membership activities and any type of school related volunteer activities/per year (max 10 points)
  - 1 point for each co-curricular and extracurricular activities listed/per year (max 10 points)
  - 1 point for each non-school volunteer activities listed/per year (max 10 points)
  - 1 point for listing college
  - 1 point for listing major
  - 10 points for leadership skills example
  - 20 points for essay on being an athlete
  - Maximum points = 100
- Points may be up to the max, but cannot exceed max.
  - High School years that will be counted will be 9<sup>th</sup> grade through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- Will decide recipients at a special meeting held by the Scholarship Selection Committee consisting of 5 members. 1-Boys Varsity Head Coach, 1-Girls Varsity Head Coach and 3-Active Booster Club Members.
